

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO.
18266, FILED AUGUST 20, 1959, BY
DIXIE VALLEY MINING CORPORATION,
TO APPROPRIATE THE WATERS OF AN
UNNAMED SPRING FOR MINING, MILLING
AND DOMESTIC PURPOSES IN CHURCHILL
COUNTY, NEVADA.

RULING

General:

A protest to the granting of the application was filed on December 21, 1959, by Michael P. Casey and Margaret Casey on grounds that its granting would adversely affect their grazing privileges in the area.

Upon investigation it was found that the protestants have a common range license with others in the area.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 18266 is herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not be detrimental to the public welfare, nor will it impair the value of existing rights. A permit will be issued under said application on receipt of the statutory permit fees, subject to the following provisions:

Stockwatering facilities must be provided by the applicant, and the facilities to be available to livestock at all times.
