FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by John G. Leisek in the office of the State Engineer on September 20, 1991 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 11167 was issued to Nevada Drilling, Inc. for said filing fee.

Requests for five references were mailed on September 20, 1991. References were received from five of the requests. The applicant was notified on March 18, 1992 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 9, 1992 at 10:30 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Jeanne Leisek on March 20, 1992.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of John G. Leisek on April 9, 1992.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of John G. Leisek is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
