FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Richard D. Fritz in the office of the State Engineer on May 12, 1989 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 9678 was issued to Richard R. Fritz for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on May 15, 1989. References were received from one of the requests. The applicant was notified on June 23, 1989 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 13, 1989 at 8:30 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail was returned marked "unclaimed" on July 19, 1989.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Richard D. Fritz on July 13, 1989.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Richard D. Fritz is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
