R U L I N G

General:

Protest to the granting of this application was filed on November 3, 1959, by John Arden, on the grounds that the pumping of the Raymond Well has stopped the flow of his Artesian well which is used for irrigation and stock watering purposes. The protestant requested that the application be granted subject to prior rights.

A field investigation on this application was made by H. E. Winchester. In his report dated October 13, 1960, it was his opinion that the granting of this application may reduce the flow of existing artesian wells but water would be available to a shallow lift pump.

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of this application will not interfere with existing water rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application No. 18308 is herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under this application on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
