

IN THE MATTER OF APPLICATION NO. 13479, FILED ON SEPTEMBER 7, 1950, BY LAFAYETTE CARTER TO APPROPRIATE 14.0 C.F.S. OF THE WATERS OF WHITE RIVER SLOUGH FOR IRRIGATION PURPOSES IN NYE COUNTY, NEVADA.

R U L I N G

General:

Protests to the granting of this application were filed as follows:

207 On June 14, 1951, by Albert Gubler, on grounds that it conflicts with the regular irrigation season.

On July 23, 1951, by Myron Adams, on grounds that its granting would interfere with the protestant's water rights.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the waters of the White River Slough are fully appropriated.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application No. 13479 are herewith sustained and the application is denied on grounds that its granting would impair the value of existing rights and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
