RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by John Gailyn Sattler in the office of the State Engineer on August 8, 1990 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10631 was issued to Five-0 Drilling for said filing fee.


The applicant was notified on December 17, 1990 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 11, 1991 at 11:00 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Board also finds that the applicant does not need a license to plug exploratory wells. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of John Gailyn Sattler on January 11, 1991.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of John Gailyn Sattler is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller and that he does not need a license to plug exploratory holes.
