RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by John A. Steir in the office of the State Engineer on March 22, 1990 together with the statutory filing fee of \$50.00. Receipt No. 10148 was issued to Lang Exploratory Drilling for said filing fee.

The applicant was never scheduled to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board because this office was advised by Lang Exploratory Drilling on April 30, 1990 to remove John Steir from the examination schedule for July, 1990 as he no longer worked for Lang. The State Engineer finds that the application of John A. Steir has since been held inactive.¹


By certified mail dated March 18, 1994 the applicant was sent an inquiry to determine his interest in obtaining a well drillers license. He was requested to notify the State Engineer's Office in writing within 30 days if he wished to be examined for a license.¹

The certified mail was returned by the postal service stamped "Returned to Sender" and was further marked "No longer here, Return."

RULING

The State Engineer hereby denies the application of John A. Steir. This ruling does not preclude the applicant from refileing an application at a later date.
