FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Tony Young in the office of the State Engineer on February 7, 1994 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12290 was issued to Western Strata Exploration for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on February 8, 1994. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on March 15, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 14, 1994 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. The applicant cancelled his examination on April 6, 1994 and requested to be rescheduled.¹

The applicant was notified on June 23, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 15, 1994 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. His company telephoned the State Engineer's Office on July 13, 1994 to cancel his examination.¹

The applicant was notified on September 12, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 13, 1994 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. His company telephoned the State Engineer's Office on October 11, 1994 to cancel his examination.¹

The applicant was notified on December 8, 1994 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 12, 1995 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada and was advised in this letter that if he cancelled this examination date, he would be noticed once more for examination, and if he cancelled that examination, the Board would consider denial of his license application. He appeared as scheduled and scored 65 on the written examination.¹ A score of 70 is required to pass.

The applicant was notified on March 6, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 6, 1995 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada. He was advised in this letter that if he cancelled this examination the Board would recommend that his application be denied. He appeared as scheduled and scored 69 on the written examination.¹ A score of 70 is required to pass.


