On July 22, 1960, the Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, advised this office that these waters are located within the boundaries of the Desert Game Range which was withdrawn by Executive Order 7373, dated May 20, 1936, for the preservation of Desert Big Horn and other wildlife and for other purposes, and that the granting of these applications would interfere with the operation of the Range by the Bureau of Land Management and the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife.

Applications Nos. 18402 and 18403 are herewith denied on grounds that their granting would interfere with the operation of the Desert Game Range by the Bureau of Land Management and the Bureau of Sport Fisheries and Wildlife and would be detrimental to the public welfare.
