RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was Filed by James Wildrick in the office of the State Engineer on August 25, 1994 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 12804 was issued to Howard Pump Inc. for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on August 25, 1994. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on June 22, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 21, 1995 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Judy Hall on June 26, 1995.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of James Wildrick on July 21, 1995.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of James Wildrick is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
