FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Raymond Ward in the office of the State Engineer on July 12, 1995 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13362 was issued to Eagle Enterprises for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on July 12, 1995. A response was received from two of the individuals. The applicant was notified on September 15, 1995 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 13, 1995 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Raymond Ward on September 22, 1995.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Raymond Ward on October 13, 1995.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Raymond Ward is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
