FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Wesley W. Teague in the office of the State Engineer on October 24, 1995 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13393 was issued to Wesley Teague for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were on file. The applicant was notified on June 19, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 19, 1996 at 9:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by (illegible) on June 21, 1996.¹

The applicant telephoned to cancel and re-schedule his examination. His well driller license file shows that he had been previously scheduled for examination on January 11, 1996 and April 11, 1996. Because the examination on July 19, 1996 was his third scheduled examination, the applicant could not be rescheduled for examination. The certified letter of June 19, 1996 told the applicant that if he did not take the examination or failed the examination, the Board would recommend that his application be denied.¹ The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Wesley W. Teague on July 19, 1996.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Wesley W. Teague is herewith denied on the ground that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
