RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Thomas L. Condrey in the office of the State Engineer on February 14, 1996 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13428 was issued to Beylik Drilling, Inc. for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on March 15, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 11, 1996 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled, scored 87 on the written examination, and failed the map examination. The Board recommended that the applicant return for retesting.¹


The applicant was notified on June 19, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on July 19, 1996 at 8:00 A.M. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Thomas L. Condrey on July 19, 1996.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Thomas L. Condrey is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
