FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Jerry J. Jensen in the office of the State Engineer on February 5, 1996 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13421 was issued to Jensen Drilling Company for said filing fee.

Four references were on file from a previous application. Mr. Jensen had been previously scheduled for examination on April 12, 1996 and July 19, 1996 and had timely cancelled these examinations. The applicant was notified on September 13, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on October 10, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Jodi Guin on September 16, 1996.¹ The certified mail stated "If you do not take this examination or fail this examination the Board will recommend that your application be denied."

The applicant did not appear as requested but telephoned the State Engineer's Office October 8, 1996 to cancel the October 10th examination. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Jerry J. Jensen on October 10, 1996.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Jerry J. Jensen is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
