RULING #4533

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Brett Arenas in the office of the State Engineer on February 21, 1996 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 13431 was issued to West Hazmat Drilling Corp.

The applicant was notified on June 19, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well drillers' Advisory Board on July 18, 1996 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. His examination was timely cancelled.¹

The applicant was notified on December 19, 1996 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on January 17, 1997 in Las Vegas, Nevada. He appeared as scheduled, scored 75 on the written examination, and failed to correctly identify a location on a topographic map.¹

The applicant was notified on March 18, 1997 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on April 11, 1997 in Las Vegas, Nevada.¹ The applicant appeared as scheduled, scored 88 on the written examination, and failed Part II, identifying a location on a topographic map. The Board recommended the denial of the application of Brett Arenas on April 11, 1997, because this was the third time Mr. Arenas was scheduled and didn't pass the examination.²



The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Brett Arenas is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
