FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Bryan Jay Blackerby in the office of the State Engineer on September 3, 1998 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 15088 was issued to Beylik Drilling Inc for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on January 12, 1999 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 12, 1999 at 8:00 A.M. in Las Vegas, Nevada.<sup>1</sup>

The applicant appeared as scheduled and scored 85 on the written examination. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Bryan Jay Blackerby on February 12, 1999.<sup>2</sup>

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and the application of Bryan Jay Blackerby is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
