FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by John M. Kennedy in the office of the State Engineer on February 11, 1999 together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 15104 was issued to Beylik Drilling Inc for said filing fee.


Requests for four references were mailed on February 12, 1999. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on January 11, 2000 by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 4, 2000 at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Paige Iannone on January 13, 2000.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of John M. Kennedy on February 4, 2000.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of John M. Kennedy is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
