RULING # 4973

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Matthew Kile in the office of the State Engineer on April 5, 2000, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 15668 was issued to Maranatha Drilling & Pump Service for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on April 5, 2000. References were received from all of the requests. The applicant was notified on July 19, 2000, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 11, 2000, at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Linda Kile on July 26, 2000.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Matthew Kile on August 11, 2000.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Matthew Kile is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
