RULING

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Alejandro Hernandez, Jr. in the office of the State Engineer on April 16, 2001, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 16237 was issued to Griffen Dewatering Corporation for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on October 10, 2001, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board on November 9, 2001, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. This was the third time that the applicant was notified for examination.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. Based upon the applicant's responses to questions about the Regulation and drilling equipment and practices, the Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation and experience as a well driller. The Statewide Well Driller's Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Alejandro Hernandez, Jr. on November 9, 2001.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Alejandro Hernandez, Jr. is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
