FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Lee Scott Robertson in the office of the State Engineer on December 12, 2002, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 17266 was issued to Badlands Drilling Corporation for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on December 16, 2002. References were received from three of the requests. The applicant was notified on January 21, 2003, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 14, 2003, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by Ginnie Mayder on January 23, 2003.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Lee Scott Robertson on February 14, 2003.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Lee Scott Robertson is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
