RULING #5265

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Robert James Salois in the Office of the State Engineer on August 5, 2002, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 17250 was issued to Boart Longyear for said filing fee.

The applicant was notified on April 16, 2003, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 15, 2003, at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada.¹

The applicant appeared as scheduled and was examined by the Board. The applicant failed Part I of the written examination. The Board finds that the applicant failed to demonstrate a good knowledge of the Regulation. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Robert James Salois on May 15, 2003.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Robert James Salois is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
