RULING #5312

FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Brian Bagoy in the office of the State Engineer on July 11, 2003, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 17729 was issued to Boart Longyear for said filing fee.

Requests for four references were mailed on July 11, 2003. References were received from two of the requests. The applicant was notified on October 16, 2003, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on November 5, 2003, at 8:00 a.m. in Carson City, Nevada. The certified mail receipt was signed by John P. Charlton on October 20, 2003.¹

The applicant did not appear as requested and did not notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Brian Bagoy on November 5, 2003.²

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 Subsection 2, the application of Brian Bagoy is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
