R U L I N G

General:

Protests to the granting of these applications were  
filed by A. C. Florio on April 11, 1949.

The Bureau of Land Management has advised us that  
an agreement was made in 1953 whereby Lone Mountain Spring  
(Application 12747) was allocated to the Florio interests,  
and Mud Spring (Application 12748) was allocated to the  
Eureka Livestock Company, with a range line division between  
the two springs.

RULING


The protest to the granting of Application 12747 is  
herewith sustained on grounds that its granting would impair  
the value of existing range rights, and be detrimental to the  
public welfare.

The protest to the granting of Application 12748 is  
herewith overruled on grounds that its granting will not im-  
pair the value of existing range rights, or be otherwise det-  
rimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued un-  
der this application on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
