General:

A protest to the granting of this application was filed on January 10, 1962, by the Ruby Hill Mining Company.

153 The water applied for will be used to irrigate the land under John B. Bonds' Desert Land Entry Nevada-046070, which was allowed by the Bureau of Land Management on April 13, 1960.

On October 6, 1960, the Bureau of Land Management granted the Ruby Hill Mining Company's Right of Way Application Nevada-056230, which covers a portion of the proposed place of use under this application. The right of way grant was made subject to John B. Bonds' Desert Land Entry Nevada-046070.

OPINION

Right of Way Application Nevada-056230 was granted subject to Desert Land Entry Nevada-046070, and it is the opinion of this office that granting Application 20066 to irrigate the lands under the Land Entry will in no way injure the protestant's rights.


RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 20066 is here-with overruled on grounds that its granting will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued under this application on receipt of the statutory permit fee.
