FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by George Campbell in the Office of the State Engineer on June 14, 2006, together with the statutory filing fee of \$100.00. Receipt No. 19106 was issued to Barbara Campbell for said filing fee.¹

The Applicant was notified on October 10, 2006, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on November 3, 2006, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. The Applicant did not appear as requested nor did he notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of George Campbell on November 3, 2006.²


CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to notify the Division of Water Resources as required in the NAS § 543.282 (2) (a).

RULING

The State Engineer concurs with the recommendation of the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board and pursuant to NAC § 534.282 (2), the application of George Campbell is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to appear as scheduled to substantiate his experience and ability as a water well driller.
