FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Mark Prueher in the Office of the State Engineer on March 20, 2007, together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for six references were mailed on March 20, 2007; there was not a response from three of the references. The Applicant was not notified by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 2007, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada, but showed up to the examination and was allowed to participate. He scored 72 on Part I, of the written examination a score of 70 is passing; he failed Part II of the examination, the description of a point of diversion.²

The Applicant was notified on July 20, 2007, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 17, 2007, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada.

The Applicant did not appear as requested nor did he notify the Office of the State Engineer that he would not appear. The Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board recommended denial of the application of Mark Prueher on August 17, 2007.³

CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to pass all three portions of the examination as required in the NAC § 534.282 (1) (g), (2) (b) and NAC § 534.286.
