FINDING OF FACT

An application for a Nevada Well Driller's License was filed by Paul Dorris in the Office of the State Engineer on October 12, 2006, together with the statutory filing fee.¹

Requests for four references were mailed on October 12, 2006; The Applicant was notified December 29, 2006, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on February 2, 2007, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas, Nevada. He appeared as scheduled and scored 38 on Part I, of the written examination, a score of 70 is passing.²

The Applicant was notified on April 2, 2007, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on May 4, 2007, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. He canceled this examination by telephone on May 1, 2007.³

The Applicant was notified on July 20, 2007, by certified mail to appear before the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on August 16, 2007, at 8:00 a.m. in Las Vegas. He appeared as scheduled and scored 68 on Part I, of the written examination, a score of 70 is passing.⁴

CONCLUSION

The State Engineer concludes that the Applicant failed to pass all three portions of the examination as required in the NAC § 534.282 (1) (g), (2) (b) and NAC § 534.286.
