R U L I N G

General:

An Application for Well Driller's License was received on May 21, 1963, from Floyd's Pump Company, Ronny E. or Carl Floyd (a co-partnership). The application was accompanied by the statutory filing fee of \$25.00 and was filed as provided for under NRS 534.140.

In accordance with the procedure of processing applications for well driller's licenses, notices for recommendations were mailed to references listed on the application on May 22, 1963. These references are as follows:

Recommendations were received by June 17, 1963, from references listed above. A recommendation was also received from Harold Beelmat. A copy of the application was mailed to the Southern Nevada Well Drillers Advisory Board on June 17, 1963, requesting their recommendation.

Opinion:


From a review of the recommendations of references and the recommendation of the Southern Nevada Well Drillers Advisory Board, it is our opinion that Ronny E. Floyd is experienced in the field but has not had sufficient experience to be qualified as a well driller. The application was filed in the name of Floyd Pump Company, Ronny E. or Carl Floyd and further indicates that this is a co-partnership. No recommendations were received from the references or the Southern Nevada Well Drillers Advisory Board for Carl Floyd. It is our opinion that it is not in the public interest to issue a license to a co-partnership. The Southern Nevada Well Drillers Advisory Board recommendation indicates that Mr. Floyd stated that he did not intend to drill himself, but to hire or sublet drilling.

RULING

The Application for a Well Driller's License by Floyd's Pump Company, Ronny E. Floyd or Carl Floyd, is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has not had sufficient experience or training to qualify him as a well driller.
