General:

Application 17582 was filed for 16.0 c.f.s. of the waters flowing in Vegas Wash Creek consisting of certain waters discharged by Clark County, Nevada, sewage disposal plant, to be diverted within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 22 and SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., to irrigate 160 acres of land within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 21 S., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., the year around.


A protest against the granting of this application was filed by R. H. Morrison on August 26, 1958, on the grounds that he is the holder and owner of record of a certain placer claim known as Protection No. 1, situate within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 26, T. 21 S., R. 22 E., M.D.B. & M., and situate in the Unknown Mining District, Clark County, Nevada, Notice of Location recorded as Instrument No. 407337 in Book 25, Page 9 of Mining Notices, Clark County, Nevada records.

Letter dated December 10, 1962, signed by George C. Monohan, County Engineer, is to the effect that title to the land described in Application 17582 has been secured.

RULING

The land in controversy has been secured by applicant; therefore, the protest to the granting of Application 17582 is herewith overruled and a permit will be issued subject to existing rights on the receipt of the statutory fee.
