General:



Protests to the granting of Application 21112 were filed on May 16, 1963, by Andre Aldax; on May 21, 1963, by C. W. Godecke; on May 22, 1963, by Fred A. and Mildred M. Thaheld. Grounds for the protests are that the proposed appropriation would interfere with, jeopardize, or curtail use of existing rights of the protestants.

Results of a field investigation of this matter which was made on June 28, 1963, a review of logs of wells drilled within the vicinity of the proposed well, consideration of information included in Ground-Water Resources - Information Series Report 1 and consideration of the location of the proposed well in relation to wells of protestants indicate that there is unappropriated water in the proposed source of supply and that the proposed appropriation would not tend to impair the value of existing rights.

RULING

The protests to the granting of Application 21112 are herewith overruled on grounds that the proposed appropriation will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued, subject to existing rights, upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
