GENERAL:

A protest to the granting of Application 20797 was filed on May 17, 1963, by the Nevada Fish and Game Commission. The grounds were that the proposed appropriation would jeopardize the existing rights owned by the protestants.


Results of a filed investigation of this matter made on August 15, 1963, a review of Water Resources Bulletin No. 8, a consideration of the proposed well locations in reference to the protestant's right, indicate there is unappropriated water in the proposed source of supply, and that the proposed appropriation would not tend to impair the value of existing rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 20797 is herewith overruled on the grounds that the proposed appropriation will not tend to impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare. A permit will be issued subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
