R U L I N G

General:

Application 20709 was filed on September 14, 1962 by Henderson Incorporated to appropriate 0.50 c.f.s. of the waters of Middle Lake Spring located within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 16, T. 43 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B.&M. and to be used for the watering of 1,000 head of cattle within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T. 43 N., R. 21 E.

On June 1, 1964, this office was informed by the Bureau of Land Management, District Office, Susanville California, that:

"Henderson Incorporated formerly had privileges within the area of T. 43 N., R. 21 E. Since the filing of Application 20709, the base properties were sold to A. J. Andrae, Cedarville, California. The grazing privileges are now controlled by A. J. Andrae."

An investigation was made on June 24, 1965.

The source of the proposed appropriation rises within the meandered boundaries of Middle Lake and is located within the fenced grazing allotment of Mr. Andrae and is on public domain.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of an application for stock watering purposes where the applicant does not have any grazing privileges would tend to complicate the administration of the grazing allotments and would therefore be detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING

Application 20709 is herewith denied on the grounds that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
