THE WATERS FROM WHITE RIVER FOR STORAGE
AND FLOOD IRRIGATION PURPOSES IN NYE
COUNTY, NEVADA.

R U L I N G

General:

Application 20819 was filed for storage of 507 acre-feet of water in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 12, T. 5 N., R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M., for flood irrigation of 218.0 acres of land.

The applicant proposes to rebuild an existing dam and use the stored water for flood irrigation of land currently being irrigated by water under Proof 01351; Certificate 1868 subject of Permit 2661; Certificate 1870 subject of Permit 3233; and Certificate 1871 subject of Permit 3234.

Opinion:


It is the opinion of this office that the waters proposed to be appropriated to supplement the above Proof and Certificates can be impounded and utilized with the allowance of enough water to pass to serve prior rights during their priority dates, without impairing existing rights.

RULING

The protest to the granting of Application 20819 is herewith overruled and a permit will be issued under said application subject to existing rights upon receipt of the statutory permit fee.
