R U L I N G

General:

Application 22345 was filed on December 1, 1964 by Joyce C Harris to appropriate 5.4 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M., and the place of use is located within the E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 27, T. 3 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B.&M.

This application was filed in support of Desert Land Entry Nevada 059279. On February 17, 1966 this office was informed by the Bureau of Land Management that DLE Nevada 059279 had been cancelled in its entirety for failure of the entrywoman to submit the required annual proof, therefore, the applicant does not exercise any control over the land.

Opinion:

It is the opinion of this office that the granting of an application where the applicant does not own or control the land on which he plans to place the water to beneficial use would be detrimental to the public welfare and the orderly development of the area.

Ruling:

Application 22345 is herewith denied on the grounds that its granting would be detrimental to the public welfare.
