DESCRIPTION OF APPLICATION:

Application 9595 was filed July 27, 1931 by A. G. McBride for stock and domestic water purposes. The point of diversion is NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 36 T. 2 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M.

PROTEST:

A protest was filed by the Sunnyside Livestock Association on the grounds: "That the granting of the application to develop water will interfere with the customary use of such land for grazing livestock by present customary and established users and the purported appropriators, which is contrary to the purpose and intent of the statutes of 1931, commonly known as the Nevada Grazing Act."

GENERAL:

A letter dated January 28, 1966, from the U. S. Bureau of Land Management, Reno, Nevada, informed this office that A. G. McBride is no longer a livestock operator in this district.

RULING

Application 9505 is hereby denied on the grounds that the applicant does not own or control the land on which the water is to be diverted and put to beneficial use.
