R U L I N G

An Application For Well Driller's License was received on May 2, 1966, from Lester G. Shaw.

On May 2, 1966, a letter was sent from this office notifying Mr. Shaw that his Application For Well Driller's License indicated the names of only three references and that four references were required. The letter requested the name of at least one additional reference.

On June 10, 1966, Mr. Shaw submitted the names of two additional references.

On May 2, 1966, requests for references were forwarded to the three persons listed on the Application. On June 13, 1966, requests for references were forwarded to the two persons indicated as references in Mr. Shaw's reply of June 10, 1966.

The applicant was advised by letter of September 28, 1966, that only three of his references had replied and that a fourth reference would be required within thirty days. No reply or additional reference has been received by this office.

The Application and references that were received were reviewed by the Statewide Well Drillers' Advisory Board on December 12, 1966, and the Board recommended denial on the grounds of insufficient references.

RULING

The Application For Well Driller's License filed by Lester G. Shaw is denied on the grounds that insufficient references were submitted to determine whether or not the applicant has had sufficient well drilling training and experience to qualify him as a well driller.


