R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 22881 was filed on December 6, 1965, by Wiley O. Sandlin to appropriate 5.4 c.f.s. of water for irrigation and domestic purposes from an underground source. The point of diversion is described as being in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, T. 15 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M. and the place of use within the E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 19, T. 15 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M. (320 acres). The application was apparently filed in support of D.L.E. 061516.

On December 12, 1966, a notice for permit fees was forwarded to Mr. Wiley O. Sandlin at 2728 West Davis, Dallas, Texas, this being his last known address. The notice was returned to the State Engineer's office marked: "Moved" - left no address." On December 13, 1966, and January 4, 1967 notices for permit fees were forwarded to Mr. J. V. Caselli, the State Water Right Surveyor who acted as Mr. Sandlin's agent. Mr. Caselli subsequently furnished this office with addresses where Mr. Sandlin could be contacted. On January 12, 1967, certified notices of permit fees due were forwarded to Mr. Sandlin in care of Mr. Dennis Noggler of Austin, Nevada, and Mr. J. V. Caselli of Reno, Nevada and on January 24, 1967 a notice was forwarded to Mr. Sandlin at 1955 S. Manhattan St., Amarillo, Texas. The latter was returned marked: "Unknown."

As of the date of this ruling the applicant has not indicated or expressed interest in the proposed appropriation. It is the responsibility of the applicant to keep the State Engineer's office informed of any change in address. Therefore, under the circumstances, the granting of a permit under application 22881 would be detrimental to the public welfare.

RULING


