R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 17632 was filed on July 31, 1958, for 2.0 c.f.s. of the waters of Swamp Seep to be used for the irrigation of 440 acres of land within portions of Section 1 T. 12 N., R. 60 E., Section 6 T. 12 N., R. 61 E., Section 31 T. 12 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M.

This application was protested on January 30, 1959, by the Preston Irrigation Company; on February 19, 1959, by William C. Goodman; and February 23, 1959, by Walter Rosevear.

An investigation in the matter of this application was made on April 10, 1964. The source of water under the proposed application is actually a sump constructed on property owned by Mr. Gardner, and the water was originally used during the construction of Highway 6. The water to be appropriated under this application is water not normally tributary to White River.

RULING

The protests against the granting of Application 17632 are hereby overruled on the grounds that there is unappropriated water at the source and the granting of application will not impair the value of existing rights or be otherwise detrimental to the public welfare.
