GENERAL:

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Application No. 21626 was filed November 8, 1963, by William L. Galkin for permission to appropriate 3.0 c.f.s. of water from an underground source for irrigation (320 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 17 S., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M. The place of use is described as within the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 8, T. 17 S., R. 49 E., M.D.B. & M.

Application No. 21626 was filed in support of Desert Land Entry Nevada 055573 with the U. S. Bureau of Land Management, Nevada Land Office, Reno, Nevada.

In response to a letter of inquiry dated March 29, 1967, from the office of the State Engineer, the U. S. Bureau of Land Management informed this office by letter dated March 31, 1967, that Desert Land Entry Nevada 055573 was cancelled on April 15, 1965.


RULING
