IN CLARK COUNTY, NEVADA)

GENERAL:


Application No. 9389 was filed December 6, 1930, by R. J. Opperdyk for permission to appropriate 0.5 cfs of water from an underground source for irrigation (50 acres) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion is described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T. 20S., R. 61E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as within a portion of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 20 and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 21, T. 20S., R. 61E., MDB&M.

Application 9389 was approved and a permit granted on December 7, 1933, for 0.5 cfs for irrigation and domestic purposes. The Proof of Commencement of Work was filed on June 1, 1934, and the Proof of Completion of Work was filed on June 1, 1936. The Proof of Beneficial Use was filed on December 31, 1941, after numerous extensions of time. A cultural map has not been filed to date in support of the culture claimed under the Proof of Beneficial Use after many requests by the State Engineer. The first notice to the Permittee that a cultural map was required was dated December 2, 1938, and the last notice was dated December 15, 1965.

RULING:

Application and Permit 9389 is herewith cancelled on the grounds that the Permittee has failed to submit a cultural map in support of his claim of application of water to a beneficial use after repeated requests from the State Engineer for additional information.
