R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application 5207 was filed August 19, 1918 by Cooper and Uniacke and Olive Cooper to change the place of use from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11, E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 14, and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 23, to portions of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11, portions of E $\frac{1}{2}$  Section 14, and a portion of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 23, T. 28 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.; and to change the point of diversion from the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 11 to the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 12, T. 29 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.&M.

The application was protested by Sylvain Siard on November 9, 1918, on the grounds that the protestant has a prior vested right to these waters and also prior applications filed for waters from Pleasant Valley Creek.


No subsequent action was taken on Application 5207 until March 1, 1968, when the applicant was given 30 days in which to express a desire that the application be processed.

Service could not be secured on the applicant at the address of record in this office.

R U L I N G

Application 5207 is denied on the grounds that the applicant failed to submit information as requested, and action without such information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
