R U L I N G

General:

87 Application No. 50 was filed on February 26, 1906 by W. G. Douglas to appropriate 60.0 c.f.s. of water from Ophir Creek for power purposes. The proposed point of diversion was described as in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  corner of Storey Lake in the center of Section 32, T. 17N., R. 19E., M.D.B.&M. The proposed place of use was not described on the application.

) A letter, dated July 26, 1968, was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unclaimed", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 50 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the approval of this application, without said information, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
