General:


Application No. 127 was filed on June 18, 1906 by J. A. Carr and Ed Mingle to appropriate 500 c.f.s. of water from Shoshone Creek for mining, milling, and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion is described as being $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles east of the Town of Shoshone and the proposed place of use is within the Town of Shoshone. This application also covers the generation of 150 horsepower.

A letter dated July 26, 1968 was sent by certified mail to the best available address for the applicants requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned, stamped "unknown", by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of the current mailing address.

RULING

Application No. 127 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or their successors in interest failed to submit requested information and the approval of this application, without this information, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
