RULING

GENERAL:

Applications 6136 and 6137 were filed May 27, 1920, by the Basco Mining Company.

Application 6136 was filed for 30.0 cfs of water for power for mining, milling and manufacturing purposes. The source of the proposed appropriation is below forks of two creeks, sometimes called Lee, Long or Furlong Creeks, tributaries of the South Fork of the Humboldt River. The water is to be diverted in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, T31N., R58E., MDB&M. The works are described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  (Lot 4) Section 19, T31N., R58E., MDB&M., and the water is to be returned to the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  (Lot 4) Section 19, T31N., R58E., MDB&M.


Application 6137 was filed for 10.0 cfs of water for power for mining, milling, transportation, and domestic purposes. The source of the proposed appropriation is a south fork of Lee, Long or Furlong Creek, a tributary of the South Fork of the Humboldt River. The water is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T31N., R58E., MDB&M. The works are described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T31N., R58E., MDB&M., and the water is to be returned to the stream in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 33, T31N., R58E., MDB&M.

A letter was sent by this office by certified mail to the applicant on August 12, 1968, requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on these applications. A return receipt signed by Charles B. Evans, Jr., and Susan E. Westbrook was returned to this office August 15, 1968.

Ruling

Applications 6136 and 6137 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application, without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
