R U L I N G

GENERAL:

Application No. 15376 was filed on November 6, 1953 for 2.0 cfs of water for irrigation and domestic purposes. The proposed source is underground and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M. The 80 acres described under the place of use are within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 7, T. 20 S., R. 53 E., M.D.B.&M.

A letter was sent to the applicant on January 31, 1967 by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on this application. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "unclaimed". It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successor in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 15376 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successor in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of this application without the information requested, would be detrimental to the public welfare.
