RULING

GENERAL:


Application 7661 was filed March 8, 1926, by Phillip W. Baker for permission to appropriate 0.1 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use are described as within the NW $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{2}$ Section 22, T13N., R70E., MDB&M. This application was filed for watering 1500 sheep.

A second and last notice for permit fees was mailed to the applicant on April 27, 1934. A final notice dated September 16, 1968, was sent by certified mail requesting the permit fees necessary before a permit could be issued. This letter was returned stamped "Unclaimed" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicant or his successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING:

Application 7661 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant has failed to submit the statutory permit fees as provided by Section 73, subdivision "F", Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913, as amended by Section 10, Chapter 106, Statutes of 1921, after proper notice dated September 16, 1968.
