RULING

GENERAL:

79
Application 7592 was filed by Mrs. Wm. Burke on December 2, 1925, for permission to appropriate 0.025 cfs of water from Louie Springs for stockwatering purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 7, T22N., R65E., MDB&M. The applicant proposed to water 2,500 head of sheep and 80 head of cattle. This application was transferred to Jim Katsaros on December 24, 1931.

A letter dated September 16, 1968, was sent to the owner of record by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application. A return receipt signed by Georgia J. Katsaros for Jim Katsaros was received in this office on September 20, 1968. A letter dated September 13, 1968, was sent to the Bureau of Land Management requesting information regarding the owner or owners of grazing allotments within the proposed place of use. Their reply dated September 18, 1968, states that Mr. Katsaros last operated in this area in 1945 and that the present range user is Mrs. F. C. Russell. The Bureau of Land Management recommended denial of this application. No reply has been received from Mrs. Katsaros.

RULING:

Application 7592 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicant or his successors in interest failed to submit requested information necessary before a permit could be issued under this application and that the granting of a permit under this application without said information and where the applicant is not a range user in the area would be detrimental to the public welfare.
