GENERAL:


Application 7881 was filed on September 21, 1926, by Myrtle and L. H. Danberg for permission to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Camp Creek for stockwatering and domestic purposes. The proposed point of diversion and place of use is described as being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T.19N., R.36E., M.D.B.&M. This application proposed to water 2,000 head of sheep or 500 head of cattle.

A letter dated October 4, 1968, was sent to the applicant requesting additional information necessary before a Permit could be issued under this application. This letter was returned stamped: "Addressee Unknown" by the Post Office Department. It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application 7881 is herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the requested information and the granting of a Permit under this Application without said information would be detrimental to the public welfare.
