RULING

GENERAL:

Application 8355 was filed on October 21, 1927, for .05 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Unnamed Spring (Mocho Spring No. 1) and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T26N., R19E., MDB&M. The place of use is described as being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 23, T26N., R19E., MDB&M.


Application 8356 was filed on October 21, 1927, for .05 cfs of water for stockwatering purposes. The proposed source is Unnamed spring (Mocho Spring No. 2) and is to be diverted in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 12, T26N., R19E., MDB&M., & the place of use is described as being within the same subdivision.

A letter was sent to the applicant on October 7, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before action could be taken on these applications. The letter was returned by the Postal Department stamped, "Addressee unknown". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Applications 8355 and 8356 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit the information requested and the approval of these applications without the information requested would be detrimental to the public welfare.
