GENERAL

Application No. 5509 was filed on May 22, 1919, to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Little Olinghouse Springs for stockwatering (500 cattle) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 30, T.21N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. Application No. 5509 was protested on August 14, 1919, by Joseph C. Effrick, et al and informally on April 18, 1935, by George A. Yori.

Application No. 5510 was filed on May 22, 1919, to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Mammoth Spring for stockwatering (500 cattle) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 28, T.21N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. Application No. 5510 was protested on August 14, 1919, by Joseph C. Effrick, et al and informally on April 18, 1935, by George A. Yori.

Application No. 5512 was filed on May 22, 1919, to appropriate 0.25 c.f.s. of water from Upper Olinghouse Canyon Springs for stockwatering (500 cattle) and domestic purposes. The point of diversion and place of use are described as within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  Section 19, T.21N., R.23E., M.D.B.&M. Application No. 5512 was protested on August 14, 1919, by Joseph C. Effrick, et al and informally on April 18, 1935, by George A. Yori.

A letter was sent to the applicants on October 30, 1968, by certified mail requesting additional information necessary before further action could be taken on Application Nos. 5509, 5510, and 5512. The letter was returned by the Post Office Department marked: "Deceased long ago". It is the responsibility of the applicants or their successors in interest to keep this office informed of their current mailing address.

RULING

Application Nos. 5509, 5510, and 5512 are herewith denied on the grounds that the applicants or their successors in interest failed to submit additional information and approval of this
